DIRECTORS REPORTS

OLD BUSINESS

NEW BUSINESS

Bob Drysdale: RVSSA, new directors and officers are now in place. The consensus with RVSSA is to keep the agreement with MRPC the same for another year except for the sale of RVSSA range passes. The

County has not agreed to the change of an entrance fee from a user fee, so this will not be started yet. RVSSA has agreed to place a porta-potty at the high power range. Due to unauthorized entry into the public range after hours RVSSA will be changing the combination on the gate locks. LTM will be out there as time allows, RVSSA also has another contractor doing the asphalt and covered area on the new 200-yard range. RVSSA could use some help with range safety officers, if you already have your credentials contact Bob if not, RVSSA will pay for the NRA range safety officer classes and supply you with the necessary equipment. Bob will have more information, as the class gets closer.

Larry Lafever: Questions regarding Richard Fox still possessing club property and what is going on with that.

Dwayne Shurfy: Asked if the club has an audit committee to look into the inventory.

John Hughes: We need to develop an audit committee to look into the books and the club inventory.
